

Fall 2012 Guild Seminar

The Guild Seminar is a point of entry to the ancient discipline of theology, which is “faith seeking understanding.” In the seminar, we learn classical approaches to major questions of perennial relevance, which ground our consideration of contemporary approaches to topics of current interest. Participation is limited to 15 people.

The Seminar will be at St. Margaret’s, on Tuesdays from 10:30 a.m. until 11:45 a.m., beginning October 23 and running through December 11. For those able to attend, it will culminate in the Guild Retreat, which is December 14-16 at Camp Mitchell.

There will be about twenty-five pages of college or seminary level reading each week from Daniel Migliore’s introduction to theology, titled “Faith Seeking Understanding,” and from the Guild Notebook, prepared by the Rev. Dr. Chris Keller, Director of the Institute for Theological Studies at St. Margaret’s.
